AM classes start at 8:45 & Dismissal at 11:45 & PM classes start 12:15 & Dismissal at 3:15. Please enter the building and wait for me to take your child. At the end, please line up in a single file line and make your way into the room for your child to be called for dismissal as you approach the front of the line.

Snack time will be in the middle of our day & we ask that you provide a snack & water bottle for your child. Some days your child might return with their snack, since we are eating through the Alphabet and will be providing snacks.

Please pack an extra pair of clothes, socks, shoes for your child in a backpack with their name on it. Accidents can happen & we want to be prepared for when they do happen!



It is such a pleasure to have your child in my classroom this year! I look forward to building a relationship with your child & providing the best education that we are capable of giving. I am so excited to be your teachers & to learn about the world around us! Let's have an amazing, fun & safe school year!

## **MS. TAMMYS CHALLENGE**

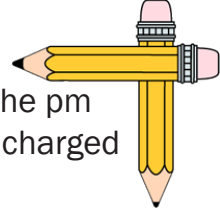
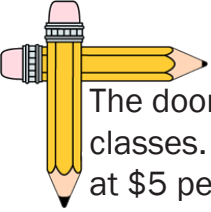

## **DROP OFF/DISMISSAL**

Students should be dropped off in the lobby at the Cynthia Neal Center, 8047 West 91st Pl.

Children will not be released to anyone under the age of 18. If someone different will be picking up your child, the teacher must be notified in writing by parent/guardian. There are no exceptions. In an emergency, please phone the office and give the person's name. This will be given to the teachers. The person must show picture identification to the teacher before taking the child.





The doors will open for dismissal promptly at 11:45 a.m. for am classes and 3:15 p.m. for the pm classes. If children are not picked up within 10 minutes of dismissal time, a late fee will be charged at \$5 per every 10 minutes late.

If the classroom doors are closed, this includes dropping off late or picking up early/late, please see office for admittance. The teachers will not open the door.



### BIRTHDAY CELEBRATIONS

We will celebrate each child's birthday at school (on the school day closest to their birthday). On this day your child is welcome to provide the snack for their classmates. Remember it must be a store bought individually wrapped snack for them. Please try not to bring cupcakes.

With your help, your suggestions, and your patience, the school year should be great fun for everyone. Above all, if you have any questions or concerns, please feel free to speak with the teachers or contact the park office. "Special Project" will be given to the parents at the end of the school year. The class will be going to the gym on Thursdays and Fridays, please make sure the children are wearing gym shoes.
