

Doug Osborne Park Construction

Doug Osborne Park will be under construction in the summer of 2024. Doug Osborne Park is an essential neighborhood park that needs an update since the last renovation was in 2002. Osborne is located at 84th Ct. and Coey Lane, off of 95th Street. The park drawing shows features to the right of this page and includes a new playground, swings, benches, a bike rack, shelter, a game table, a spinner, painted games such as Hopscotch, and an outdoor fitness area. Residents attended a focus group in the summer of 2022 to assist with gathering input of what amenities should be included in the park so we are very excited to see the project moving forward. This is an Open Space Lands Acquisition and Development grant awarded by the Illinois **Department of Natural Resources in the amount** of \$241,700. This is a 50% matching grant so the entire cost of this project will be approximately \$483,400.

SEASON PASS INFORMATION: PASSES WILL GO ON SALE MAY 1.

Season passes for **residents only** are available for \$15 per child before May 24th. Starting May 28th, the price goes to \$20 per child. Adults are free! Passes available at Cynthia Neal Center only during regular business hours, Monday thru Friday 9 a.m. - 5 p.m.. **RESIDENTS MUST PRESENT EACH CHILD'S GOVERNMENT ISSUED BIRTH CERTIFICATE ALONG WITH TWO (2) CURRENT UTILITY BILLS TO OBTAIN A PASS**. In place of the birth certificate, you can use the 2023 pass. Each child in your family, who will be going into the water, must be issued a pass regardless of age. They must present the pass for admission to the splash pad. If your card is lost or stolen, a \$5 charge will apply for a new one. **Non-residents are prohibited from obtaining an annual pass and must pay the daily rates as outlined above**.

SPLASH PAD RULES:

Water will not be turned on unless recorded temperature at Midway is 74° or above.

No food or glass containers are allowed in the Splash Pad area.

Climbing on equipment is not allowed.

Do not hang clothes or towels on the fence or trees.

Groups of 10 or more must have a permit.

Children playing in the water MUST have proper swim attire. No street clothes allowed in the Splash Pad.

NO DIAPERS. Rubber pants are required. No diaper changing allowed in the fenced area.

The Park District reserves the right to limit entry if the facility is at its reasonable capacity.

In the event of threatening weather the Splash Pad will be closed.

Patrons engaging in horseplay without regard for the safety of others will be asked to leave.

There will be no refund issued if you are asked to leave.

Per the Health Department, diapers and Little Swimmers are not acceptable. Children that would wear those must wear rubber/plastic pants over it. Pants available for purchase at splash pad.

SPLASH PAD RENTALS/PERMITS:

EXCLUSIVE PARTIES: You can host an exclusive private party at the splash pad 10:00 a.m. - 11:30 a.m. or 6:45 p.m.-8:15 p.m.. The rental fee for a resident group is \$170 and the non-resident group rate is \$180 for up to 50 people. Exclusive parties also are allowed in the picnic area for 2-hours after (a.m. party) or before (p.m. party) their scheduled splash pad time. A \$50 refundable security deposit is required for all rentals. All rental fees are required 7 business days prior to your rental date. All money must be paid before we confirm the date. The \$50 will be refunded by mail within 30 business days after the rental. If any damage is present after the party rental, the deposit will not be refunded. Any group of 10 or more must have a permit. The total number of people attending will need to be included when scheduling the party/rental. Room rentals are available on the weekends and evenings at an additional price. Call 708-598-1233 for more information.

PRESCHOOL 2024-2025

We have designed a balanced preschool program ready to meet the educational, social, emotional, motor, and creative needs of children 3 to 5 years. Preschool children will be introduced to letters, numbers, colors, shapes, and other basic concepts. Pre-Kindergarten children will be introduced to phonics, pre-writing skills, fine motor skills, reading readiness, and number concepts. Story-time, music activities, and seasonal art projects will be included in the program. **Children must be 3 years old by September 1, 2024. All children must be able to take care of their own bathroom needs.**

Registration is accepted at the Cynthia Neal Center, 8047 W. 91st Place. The office is open Monday thru Friday, 9:00 a.m. - 5:00 p.m.

You must bring your child's birth certificate and immunization records with you at the time of registration. A note from your doctor stating that your child is up-to-date on his/her shots is also acceptable. There is a \$100 non-refundable/non-transferable deposit required when you register. *Non-

GENERAL INFORMATION

REGISTRATION INFORMATION

- Walk up registration is accepted at the Cynthia Neal Center & Krueger Park Recreation Center when the building is open. After 5 p.m., drop off registration is accepted with a check payment. **No receipt will be mailed to you unless you request one.** You may use the drop box located to the left of the front doors at the Cynthia Neal Center. This drop box is accessible 24 hours a day.
- All mail-in registration will be accepted at the Cynthia Neal Center, 8047 W. 91st Place. All mail-in registration will be processed the day it is received during registration dates. Please be sure to include the mail-in registration form, and fill-in all necessary information, as well as signing the waiver on the registration form. Mail the registration form along with appropriate program fees, and include non-resident fee when applicable. Make checks payable to the Hickory Hills Park District. Please do not send cash. The park district is not responsible for lost or late mail/drop box registration.
- No eligible participant shall, on the basis of race, sex, creed, national origin or disability be denied equal access to program activities, services or benefits or be limited in the exercise of any right, privilege advantage or opportunity.
- Registration fees for late registration will not be prorated and late fees may be added.

The park district is committed to conducting its recreation programs and activities in the safest manner possible. Participants and parents or guardians registering their children in recreation programs must recognize that there is an inherent risk of injury when choosing to participate in recreation activities. The park district continually strives to reduce such risks and insists that all participants follow safety rules and instructions. Please recognize that the park district does not carry medical accident insurance for injuries sustained in its programs. The cost of this insurance would make program fees prohibitive.

Due to insurance regulations, children are not allowed in adult classes with parents. The Park District is also not responsible for children left unsupervised while a parent attends a class.

CHILD PICK-UP POLICY

To insure the safety of the children, we ask you to drop off and pick up your child(ren) promptly when classes are over. Also, please instruct your child(ren) to wait inside the building for you when class is over. Instructors/Coaches will not allow child(ren) under 10 years of age to leave without an adult or older sibling. Children, whose parents fail to pick them up before a specified time, will be taken to the office until a parent arrives. If a child is not picked up within 10 minutes, the park district will contact the child's emergency phone number. If the park district cannot reach anyone, the child will be held until closing time or for a maximum of two hours, whichever comes first. There will be a \$5.00 late fee per child assessed for every 10 minutes you are late picking up your child(ren) after class. All fees must be paid in cash before your child can continue in the class or register for any future classes. If no one can be contacted at closing time of the building, or by the maximum time limit of two hours, the police will be contacted and your child will be taken into protective custody until a parent or guardian can be notified. Once under police jurisdiction, the park district is not responsible for any legal ramifications. If you are late and the building is closed, and you are unable to reach park district staff:

- 1. Contact the people on your emergency form to verify whether or not any of them have your child.
- 2. Call the police (708-598-1313) if you cannot locate your child. More than two late pick-ups may result in your child being dropped from the program. No refund will be given.

SKATE PARK RULES

OPEN APRIL 1 - OCT 31

- · Hours of operation: 9 a.m. until dusk
- Do not use if equipment is broken or wet. Contact the Hickory Hills Park District Maintenance Department at 708-598-1233 ext. 8.
- Skaters/bikers are responsible for inspecting equipment prior to using to ensure that it has not been vandalized and is safe for skating.
- Helmets, knee & elbow pads, wrist guards are required while skating/bikers.
- No ramps, boxes, etc. may be brought into the park.
- · NO GLASS in any form allowed.
- No alcohol, drugs, tobacco or vaping allowed.
- All participants will refrain from acting in any manner which may cause or contribute to death or injury to themselves or to any other persons.
- All participants will act within the limits of their ability.
- Participants are allowed to skate/bike only inside the facility.
- Profanity, fighting or any disorderly conduct will result in expulsion from the skate park.
- Graffiti of any kind is not allowed, this includes but not limited to stickers, markers, and/or spray paint.
- All participants will maintain control of their equipment while skating. The park district is not responsible for lost/stolen equipment.
- Climbing fence to gain access is strictly prohibited. Violators will be subject to arrest.

- · Park sponsored programs have priority.

REFUND POLICY

- Refund requests for any class MUST be made Monday through Friday, 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., and at least 48 hours prior to the program's second meeting. After the program's second meeting, no refund will be issued.
- An administrative fee will be assessed on all credits or refunds. Credits will be charged a \$1 administrative fee, and all refunds by check will be charged a \$5 administrative fee.

Refunds for special events, one day program/events, and trips will be issued only if cancelled by the Park District.

- There will be a 30-day waiting period on all refunds. All refunds will be mailed. **No cash or credit card refund will be given.**
- Refunds/prize money checks not cashed within 180 days will be voided and considered a donation to the park district.

PARK GUIDELINES

For your safety and protection, the Hickory Hills Park District Board of Commissioners have established certain rules so that everyone may enjoy the park safely. You are required to comply with the following guidelines: **All animals, with the exception of service animals, are prohibited in the parks.** Violations are subject to a minimum \$250 fine to a maximum or \$20,000 fine. All service animals must be leashed. Parks close according to posted signs.

BEHAVIOR/DISCIPLINE POLICY

The Hickory Hills Park District has a formal discipline policy for disruptive behavior during programs/classes. You may obtain a copy from the office. The Hickory Hills Park District reserves the right to dismiss a participant and/or volunteer for disruptive behavior. Participants and volunteers are expected to exhibit appropriate behavior at all times. The following guidelines were developed to make park district programs safe and enjoyable for all participants. PARK USAGE

This is due to keeping the grass and ball fields looking good for park district programs and leagues.

- · No setting up of tables, chairs, inflatables, etc.
- Firearms are prohibited in any park, playground, and facility.

ATHLETIC FIELD PERMIT

A permit is necessary for any formal or informal use of 7 or more people using our athletic fields. Permits will be issued according to availability beginning March 1, but not confirmed until April 1. For details on athletic fields call 708-598-1233 ext. 0. There are no picnic or park rentals/permits, except for the Krueger Park Picnic Shelter (weekends only).


